Mike Sadler's legacy is our inspiration.

He lived an extraordinary life of impeccable character. His commitment to helping others, contributing to the community, and embracing his love of family, friends, and society was constant.

At MSU, Mike earned a Bachelor's degree in Applied Engineering Sciences and a Master's degree in Public Policy. He was a two-time, first-team All-American, and the first ever, four-time Academic All-American in MSU history. Mike earned the Big Ten Conference Medal of Honor and the National Football Foundation's Scholar Athlete Award in 2014. He received the Cotton Bowl's Scholar Athlete Award in 2015 and he was inducted into the MSU Hall of Fame in 2016. Mike received unparalleled recognition in academics and athletics.

Yet, he is most remembered for his strong character, his kindness to others, his quick wit, and his unpredictable sense of humor. Mike inspired people across the country to reach higher and work harder to be their best selves, while finding the prize in each day of their journeys. He intentionally created his legacy during his life.

Mike focused on six pillars in building his legacy, and they are the basis for all aspects of our work at Michael Sadler Foundation.
